### Register for aeRos Account


**aeRos™ BASIC** Data Management solution allows users to save their test data in the aeRos Cloud and then retrieve it from anywhere at any time with a standard Internet browser. aeRos BASIC is free to all owners of AFL's ROGUE modular test equipment.

**aeRos™ PRO** Workflow Management solution allows users to manage their entire testing workflow and enables seamless and efficient communications and data management. aeRos PRO is available in multiple License configurations including monthly, annual and lifetime.



#### To Register:

- 1 Type [aeros.AFLglobal.com](https://aeros.AFLglobal.com) into your standard browser (such as Chrome or Safari) and press Enter. At Welcome screen you will see options:
  - 'Sign in' (for already registered users)
  - 'Register' (for first time users)
- 2 Click 'Register for aeRos account'.
- 3 At registration screen, select type of your aeRos Licence and enter account information:
  - aeRos PRO account - enter a license key
  - aeRos BASIC account - enter your ROGUE device serial number
- 4 Enter the required Organization Information.
- 5 When done, press Register.



## aeRos Dashboard Overview

Once logged in to aeRos, the first screen you see is the Projects Dashboard. From this screen you can see all the Projects for your Organization and easily access various setup screens, menus, and useful tools.

Main Menu bar — It contains icons/tabs for a quick access to various setup screens or menus. Click on an icon/tab to display the associated setup screen or menu. See table below for details.

### Setup Screens, Menus and Tools

Some features on the Projects Dashboard may only appear with special permission.

Ref	Screen/Feature	Description
1	Projects Dashboard	When in any other screen, click to display the Projects Dashboard, which displays all projects for your organization.
2	Test Setups Screen	Allows you to manage Test Setups for your organization.
3	Test Limits Screen	Allows you to manage Test Limits. It contains standard or user-defined limits that you can use as part of your setups.

Ref	Screen/Feature	Description
4	Organization Menu	This menu provides access to several screens that allow you to manage Users, Contacts/Customers, and License information that you have for your Organization.
5	Logout Menu	Allows you to logout or change the password.
6	Help Button	Click to see help for the currently displayed screen.
7	Search Box	The 'Search' feature allows you to search for projects by entering keywords into the search box field.
8	Search Filter	Allows you to filter searches and display filtered data by 'Active', 'Hidden' or see both 'Active and Hidden' projects.
9	Project Row	By clicking on a project row you can display an individual project and associated with this project screens (Fibergroups, Results, Reports, Project team). <b>Note:</b> You can only display an 'Active' project <b>A</b> . If Project is 'Hidden' (disabled) <b>B</b> , it will be indicated by grayed-out name of a project. You may enable a 'Hidden' project by clicking the Reload button  .
10	Project Progress Bar	These bars can be displayed by clicking on the Details button  . When displayed, each progress bar may contain up to three color-coded sections to indicate the status of a Project by a number of fibers failed (red/x) <b>D</b> , passed (green/✓) <b>C</b> or incomplete (gray/?) <b>E</b> . You may click on each section to view filtered results.
11	Tools Panel	Buttons located on tools panel provide shortcuts for specific actions. See details by clicking the Help button  .
