## aeRos® Cookies Policy (rev. 10/24)

aeRos is a cloud-based, workflow management on-line platform (“**aeRos**”), provided by AFL Telecommunications LLC, a company incorporated under the laws of Delaware (“AFL”), that allows users of AFL Testing & Instrumentation equipment, e.g., Rogue® field test units, to easily and efficiently manage their test process from end to end, including the facilitation of two-way communication and data exchange from engineering to project management to a technician in the field, and storage of data immediately and securely in the cloud enabling access to test results when and where needed (“**Services**”).

AFL may use cookies in the operation of aeRos and in the providing the Services. By using aeRos and the Services, you consent to the use of cookies. Cookies are generally small pieces of text or other information sent by your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows aeRos and/or the Services, or a third-party, to recognize you and make your next visit easier, make aeRos and/or the Services more useful to you, and/or to provide AFL information about how its users use aeRos and/or the Services. Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies.

When you use and access aeRos and/or the Services, AFL may place a number of cookies files in your web browser. AFL may use the cookies for the following purposes: to enable certain functions of aeRos and/or the Services, to provide analytics, to store your preferences, to enable advertisements delivery, including behavioral advertising, etc. AFL may use both session and persistent cookies on aeRos and/or in the Services and AFL may use different types of cookies to run the Service, such as essential cookies to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. AFL may further use third-party cookies to, e.g., report usage statistics of aeRos and/or the Services, deliver advertisements on and through aeRos and/or the Services, and so on.

You do not have to accept cookies and consent can be withdrawn at any time. You can do this by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. If you'd like to delete cookies or instruct your web browser to delete or refuse cookies, please visit the help pages of your web browser. Please note, however, that if you delete cookies or refuse to accept them, you might not be able to use all of the features AFL offers, you may not be able to store your preferences, and some of our pages might not display properly.
